

Guest Room

Our rooms are designed in traditional Japanese styles-with tatami mats. When you enter the room, please take off your shoes or slippers at the entrance and step up on the tatami. In few minutes, the maid will bring you a cup of tea and sweet and inform you of the bathing and dining hours. Please tell your maid when you want to eat your dinner between 6:00pm to 8:00pm and for breakfast, between 7:00am to 9:00am. Drinks are not included in the meal, if you would like to have something to drink with your dinner, please also tell the maid in advance.



Safety Box

If you would like to store any valuable items, there is a safety box in your room. Or you can deposit your valuable items to the reception.

The safety box is usually located in bottom of the closet.

How to use the safety box in your room

- 1) There are 4 doors in the box.
- 2) You enter 4 digit numbers and push one of 4 red buttons.
Please remember those 4 numbers will be your ID number.
You need the number when you open the safety box.
- 3) Those buttons indicate the location of the 4 doors.
One of those doors you selected opens up automatically.
- 4) Put your valuable items in the box and close it.
The button lights up to show which box you are using.
- 5) When you want to open the safety box, you enter your ID number and push the red lighted button.
- 6) Then the door opens
- 7) After you open the safety box to take the items, your ID numbers will not be valid
So, when you want to use it again, please go over from the first step.



(If it is different kind of safety box, you just simply lock the door with key)

Inside of Closet



When you open the closet, you find a set of yukata and plastic bag for each guest. There are toothbrush and face towel in the plastic bag. When you go to the public bath, please bring this bag with you. You do not need to take bath towel from your room. There are bath towels in the public bath rooms for you to use.
